

The interpretation of the Feldmann family coat of arms

The family coat of arms shows a red stylized rose on silver grounds.

The helmet is a frog mouth helmet in silver. The frog's mouth helmet with the narrow sighting device and the conical end profile reached up to the chest and to the neck and was screwed or strapped. This helmet can be found especially in the 15th and 16th century and was often used in citizen coats of arms. The helmet ornament repeats the red stylized rose. The helmet cover repeats the shield colors and surrounds the shield like a plant. The inside shows the silver of the metal and the outside the red of the rose.

The shield colour silver stands for cleanliness, wisdom, innocence, chastity, joy, peace and sincerity. The colour red of the rose stands for military strength and generosity.

The rose is a symbol of hope and joy. With red flowers it is a symbol of grace, beauty and sometimes martyrdom.
